Application Package & Background Information 37th Parliamentary Session February 9th-11th, 2024 - Vancouver, BC

WHAT IS VYP? Vancouver Youth Parliament (VYP) is a project of the BC Youth Parliament (BCYP), a youth organization that recognizes every young person's potential to lead and serve in the community. The Vancouver Youth Parliament is the longest continuously running of these projects, providing an opportunity for youth from the age of 14-18 to develop skills in leadership, organization, public speaking, and the parliamentary process. VYP is not affiliated with any political party and is a non-profit organization. Membership in VYP begins with attending the Parliamentary Session at UBC and continues throughout 2024. VYPs ACTIVITIES VYP's year begins with the Parliamentary Session from February 9-11, 2024. Members meet at UBC and use the parliamentary style of debate to debate issues of local, national, and international importance. At Session, Members:

- Meet young people from all over the province;
- Debate current local, national, and international issues;
- Learn about debating and the rules of parliamentary procedure;
- Elect VYP's Premier and Leader of the Opposition for the 38th Parliament.

WHO CAN ATTEND? Each year 50 youth are "elected" to VYP as representatives of their communities. Each applicant must be nominated by an organization committed to youth (i.e. a school, community group, club, municipality or church). Five members of that group must indicate their support by signing the application form.

To be eligible for membership you must be:

- Age 14 18 (inclusive) as of Dec. 31th, 2024;
- A resident of Vancouver, North Vancouver, West Vancouver, Richmond, Delta, Squamish, Whistler, and other municipalities in the Sea-to-Sky region;
- Nominated by an organization committed to youth;

Due to the limited number of seats, only 50 applicants will be selected to become Members.

SESSIONAL ARRANGEMENTS Parliamentary Session is held at the Liu Institute at the University of British Columbia. Session runs from approximately 4pm on Friday, February 9th to 2:30pm Sunday, February 11th. Members return home at the end of each day's activities. Members must attend all of Session and must contact the Chief Returning Officer before applying if this presents a problem. The registration fee includes dinner on Friday; lunch and dinner on Saturday; lunch on Sunday, and all paper materials, including a copy of the parliamentary journal.

PRE – SESSIONAL INFORMATION The Chief Returning Officer will notify all applicants by email or mail as to their acceptance status by early February. Accepted Members are provided with an orientation package prior to session.

REGISTRATION FEE The registration fee for each member is **\$60**. A cheque or money order made payable to the **Youth Parliament of B.C. Alumni Society** must be sent with the application form or follow a fax or e-mail with the original signed application as soon as possible (any acceptance is not final until a Registration fee is received). We are not able to receive credit cards or eTransfer. Registration fees will be held onto (but not cashed) for those on the waitlist and returned to those not accepted. **NSF cheques are subject to a \$45 fee.** Applicants who are in financial need are first encouraged to approach school and community groups to contribute to the cost of the application fee. For those who are not able to secure outside funding, a limited amount of **financial support is available from VYP.** For more information, please contact the Chief Returning Officer **before** the February 4th application deadline and attach a letter of request along with your application form. So that we can provide support for as many members as possible, we encourage applicants to submit a cheque for whatever portion of the application fee they can afford. Requests for financial assistance cannot be considered after applicants have been accepted as members.

CANCELLATION Accepted members who cancel on or before February 5th will receive a refund of their registration fee minus a \$25 cancellation fee. No refunds will be issued to any member cancelling after February 5th.
